

We are a free, confidential, counselling walk-in clinic, providing service for children and youth, **3-19 years** (up until their 20th birthday), and their families.

- We provide single-session counselling.
- We focus on what clients would like to address, and feel is important.
- Therapists work together with children, youth and their families.
- Together, we will build upon existing strengths to create a plan for positive change.
- The clinic operates on a first-come, first-served basis.

People come to us for many different reasons including family issues, strategies for positive change, stress management, relationship challenges, parenting support, youth development, substance use concerns, etc. We will listen to you without judgment. Our clinic is very knowledgeable about Durham Region, and can provide information about **community resources** and services. Often clients feel better about their situation after one session, and are hopeful about moving forward.

The **Durham Counselling Walk-in Clinic** is located at Carea Community Health Centre (Ajax site), 360 Bayly St. W., Unit 5 in Ajax. For further information, please call the Clinic Coordinator at 905-428-1212.
