ABOUT GRANDVIEW

The Grandview Children's Treatment Centre (GCTC) will become the new headquarters for Grandview Kids, providing programs and services to children and youth in the Durham Region.

Programs and services include: Centre-based rehabilitation services, including occupational therapy, physiotherapy, speech-language pathology, therapeutic recreation, audiology, infant hearing, blind low vision, social work; Ontario Autism Program (OAP); Preschool Outreach Program (POP); School-Based Rehabilitation (SBR); Developmental Paediatricians and specialized medical services, including a Paediatric Complex Care Program; Family/caregiver resources and support; and Campbell Children's School.

The GCTC connects children and youth to the services and programs they need as early as possible and as they transition into adulthood. The Centre will contribute to the growing demand of services for children by reducing wait times, increasing accessibility and helping to be build and improve the range of services for young people. Current demand for services from Grandview is approximately 11,500 children and youth waiting to access care.

Amico, Sacyr and design partner, Parkin, form Children First Consortium, the team chosen by Infrastructure Ontario and Grandview Kids to design, build and finance the new GCTC. Municipal approvals are currently being finalized and construction is proposed to start this Fall.
