

“I AM A PROMISE” AWARD

The purpose of the, “I am a Promise” Award, in honour of Ruth Althouse, is to encourage and assist students with physical disabilities and/or speech disorders who are entering or continuing post secondary education.

Eligibility Requirements:

- A. The applicant shall be a former student of Campbell Children’s School and/or a former or current client of Grandview Children’s Centre.
- B. The applicant shall have made application to attend a Community College or University in September or the applicant is returning to a Community College or University in September.

The Procedure:

Applications or Nominations must be submitted by May 31 indicating the Community Colleges and/or Universities to which the student has made an application. A copy of the applicant’s latest transcript must be included with the application.

A Selection Committee consisting of a minimum of three people, representing Campbell Children’s School, Grandview Children’s Centre and the Founder will review the applications and choose up to two people who meet the requirements.
