Grandview Kids is Durham Region's Children's Treatment Centre. Headquartered in Ajax, Grandview Kids operates four additional satellite locations in Bowmanville, Oshawa, Port Perry and Whitby. We support children and youth with communication, physical and developmental needs to live, learn and play. Through the expertise and passion of Team Grandview, and collaboration with dedicated community partners, we work to ensure every child and youth can live at their full potential.

Our history

Grandview Kids' journey began in 1953 when a group of parents who were concerned about travelling back and forth to Toronto to access care for their children took action to create a clinic in Oshawa. Grandview Kids' name, location and administration have changed over the years, but our commitment to provide quality care and services to children, youth and families has remained constant.

Referral process

We accept self-referrals from clients and caregivers through our website at grandviewkids.ca/self-referrals. On our self-referral webpage, click "Complete the self-referral" to initiate one. Our Service Navigation offers a "No Closed Door" policy. This means our team will do their best to connect clients/caregivers with services to meet their needs, which could be offered by Grandview Kids or other organizations in the community. Eligibility for services is identified based on an established set of criteria. Physician referrals are required for Medical Services, using our electronic referral form at grandviewkids.ca/physician-referrals.



Ability Acceptance Program

The Ability Acceptance Program is available to local businesses, schools, licensed child care centres and community organizations in the Durham Region. The program enhances understanding, acceptance and inclusive practices for those with different needs or abilities. 
