


Which Grandview Kids Applied Behaviour Analysis (ABA) service model is right for my child?

Age and goals

- Up to age 11
- 5+ goals

Time commitment

- Continuous service model
- 2-5 sessions per week (2.5 hours in length)

Involvement

- Parent/caregiver attendance and involvement in sessions varies (as discussed with clinical team)
- In-person/Centre-based

Things in common

- Supervised by a Board Certified Behaviour Analyst, including consultation with/goal development from a Speech-Language Pathologist and Occupational Therapist, as needed
- Individualized goals
- Utilizes ABA principles
- 1:1 service delivery ratio
- Family-centred care
- Eligible for Ontario Autism Program (OAP) Core Clinical Services

Age and goals

- Up to age 18
- 1-4 goals

Time commitment

- Minimum of 12 weeks of service
- 1-4 sessions per week (45 minutes in length)

Involvement

- Parent/caregiver attendance and involvement is highly encouraged
- In-person or virtual
