



Family Engagement Team (FET) services

Caring for a child or youth with physical, communication or developmental needs can leave some caregivers feeling isolated and alone. Our Family Engagement Team is comprised of caregivers to Grandview clients and former clients (grads), who use their lived experience and specialized training to support others in their journey. As soon as you're referred to Grandview Kids, you have access to a number of helpful Family Engagement Program services.

Workshops

A series of workshops are held throughout the year for Grandview Kids caregivers. Some are specific to programs, while others are good-for-all. Registration is usually required.

- **Self-care Workshop:** Create your very own self-care toolkit. Discusses boundaries, strategies for overload and how to see the value in self-care.
- **Goal-setting Workshop:** Teaches families how to set meaningful goals as a part of their child's care team. Caregivers receive a registration link shortly after intake.
- **Paperwork Party:** Help with funding applications and other forms in a group setting. Topics include Special Services at Home (SSAH) and Assistance for children with Severe Disabilities (ACSD); other topics can be requested.
- **New Autism Diagnosis:** Helps parents understand first steps to take after their child is diagnosed with Autism, including navigating the Ontario Autism Program (OAP) and other resources.

Events

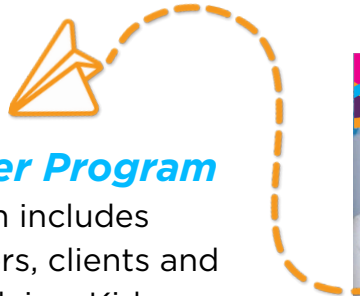
