



## Guidelines for Clients and Families regarding service exclusion due to illness

Grandview Children’s Center is committed to providing a safe and healthy work environment for all staff, physicians, volunteers, students, contractors, clients and their families, visitors and other members of the general public working at or visiting our facility. In this regard, children and other family members with the following conditions should remain at home and away from others:

CONDITION	EXCLUSION PERIOD
Chickenpox	All pox must be scabbed over and the individual is well enough to participate in all activities with no accompanying fever.
Diarrhea	24 hours after Diarrhea stops.
Fever	No symptoms for 24 hours.
Head Lice	Until after first treatment and no visible nits remain in the hair.
Impetigo	Until the antibiotic prescribed by a doctor has been taken for at least 24 hours.
Upper Respiratory or Flu-like illness	Until 5 days after symptoms began and the child feels better.
Bacterial Pink Eye	Following examination by primary physician and appropriate antibiotic treatment has been taken for at least 24 hours and no discharge is present.
Ringworm	Treatment must have initiated and area covered.
Strep Throat	Until the antibiotic prescribed by a doctor has been taken for at least 24 hours and there is no new or worsening cough or any trouble breathing.
Vomiting	No vomiting for a minimum of 24 hours

This list is not exhaustive, if your child is ill, it is recommended that you see your primary physician.
