Summary of Duties:

Reporting to the Director, Quality, Risk and Continuous Improvement, the Project Manager, Continuous Improvement supports the planning and execution of priority projects, improvement capacity building and organizational effectiveness to ensure that client services are consistent with the Centre's Mission, Vision and Values

Specific responsibilities include but are not limited to:

Continuous Quality Improvement and Project Management

- Facilitate and manage the identification, planning, implementation, and monitoring of quality improvement initiatives/projects in accordance with recognized standards, i.e. Model for Improvement, Lean methodology, PMI, etc.
- Support successful change management with relevant stakeholders both internal and external to the organization
- Monitor quality improvement activities, identify and evaluate root causes for performance shortfalls and gaps, and recommend strategies for improved outcomes.
- Assist in developing insights from data and statistical analysis; collaborating with stakeholders to measure improvement outcomes related to client experience, staff engagement as well as clinical and financial performance.
- Coordinate and manage the activities of the team to meet the project plan, and address changes to
 plan or scope in a systematic way using defined project/change management practices (including
 ensuring that the full implications for the change have been assessed, communicated and approved)
