Summary of Duties

Under the general direction of the Clinical Manager, the Occupational Therapist completes an assessment of clients referred for occupational therapy service and identifies problem areas; establishes written treatment goals and plans to address client problem areas (which may include use of Applied Behaviour Analysis Principles and Strategies); provides direct and indirect client care in accordance with the treatment plan; evaluates the impact of occupational therapy intervention on identified problems; maintains communication with all other team members regarding client care; participates with other organizations within the community; documents occupational therapy involvement in client care; oversees activities in the occupational therapy area which may be carried out by the Therapy Assistant; ensures that the environment of the occupational therapy treatment area meets client's needs; maintains clinical competence; maintains communication with all other staff members; supports departmental/Centre efforts in Quality Management activities, as required; participates in education, orientation and public relations, as required; maintains a safe work environment; performs designated administrative duties; performs other related duties, as assigned.

Qualifications

- Masters Degree in Occupational Therapy or equivalent
- Registration with College of Occupational Therapists.
- 2 years' experience in a related (paediatric) clinical setting.
- Knowledge of occupational therapy assessment and treatment principles related to paediatrics.
- Knowledge of home renovations, complex equipment, and transition to adult services required.
- Knowledge of equipment, adaptive devices and standardized tests.
