Founded in 1953, Grandview Kids is Durham Region's only Children's Treatment Centre, serving more than 10,000 clients, aged 0 to 21, every year. Referral process

We accept self-referrals from clients and caregivers through our website at <u>grandviewkids.ca/self-referrals</u>. On our self-referral webpage, click "Complete the self-referral" to initiate one.

Our Service Navigation offers a "No Closed Door" policy. This means our team will do their best to connect clients/caregivers with services to meet their needs, which could be offered by Grandview Kids or other organizations in the community. Eligibility for services is identified based on an established set of criteria.



Audiology

Identifying children and youth who are born deaf or hard of hearing, or at risk of developing hearing loss.



Autism Program & Purchased Services

Range of group and 1:1 Applied Behaviour Analysis (ABA) programs for children or youth with ASD diagnoses.



Medical Services

Doctors and specialists, including developmental paediatricians, offering consultation, assessment and diagnositic services.



Family Engagement

Former clients (grads) and caregivers use lived experience to provide peer support, resource navigation and networking.



Occupational Therapy

Helping children and youth participate in activities of daily living.



Physiotherapy

Helping children and youth move, as well as build endurance, strength and coordination.



Preschool Outreach Program (POP)

Provides support to licensed early childhood centres and educators.



School & community -based rehab

Work with students, school staff and caregivers to ensure students are able fully participate in school.



Service Navigation

Support referral and intake process, as well as navigation to other community resources.



Social Work

Supporting the physical, social and emotional well-being of Grandview clients and caregivers.

Speech-Language Pathology

Helping children and youth to communicate by having speech, language and communication needs addressed.



Therapeutic Recreation

Giving children and youth the chance to play through activities that help them learn, gain confidence and interact.
