Grandview School is a Section 68 school that collaborates with Grandview Children’s Centre to provide an integrative academic and therapeutic program for young children. Programs are based on the Ontario curriculum and each child has an IEP and the goal of both teams is to meet the education and therapy goals of each child.

QUALIFICATIONS:

1. Bachelor of Education degree;
2. Certificate of Qualification and Registration (in good standing) from the Ontario College of Teachers;
3. Special Education Specialist an asset;
4. Able to work with each child’s unique abilities as part of a team;
5. Able to apply differentiated instruction to help students achieve their highest level of independence;
6. Possesses exceptional verbal, non-verbal, and written communication skills to facilitate various interactions with parents, students, support staff, therapists, and administration;
7. Proof of full vaccination against COVID-19.

At Grandview School, all employees are required to provide a Criminal Reference Check with the Vulnerable Sector component issued within six months of the commencement of employment as a condition of employment.
